INDUSTRY OVERVIEW

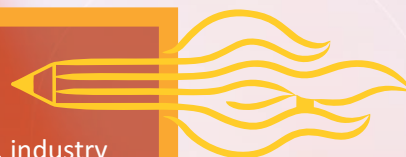
